



Registrable Interests

On 2nd July 2012 Ivybridge Town Council adopted a new Code of Conduct, as required following the abolition of the old standards regime. The Code requires Councillors to have a duty to promote and maintain high standards of conduct and to act in accordance with the principles of public life, namely, selflessness, honesty, objectivity, accountability, openness, personal judgement, respect for others, duty to uphold the law, stewardship and leadership. All Councillors are then to register any interests they hold and all Town Councillors have completed the relevant paperwork.
