In addition to the accompanying slides, attendees were issued with workbooks allowing some preparation before the lectures. A good point with the workbooks was that there was a section to be filled in about the security of one's own property working in a logical sequence from the environment, boundary protection, outbuildings, shell of the house and the interior including marking removable assets. Unfortunately it was mentioned that would-be burglars look for dwellings clearly occupied by older people – hand rails and unweeded front gardens, and these criteria fitted my property to a T.

One point that I particularly noted was the duty of care the householder owes to visitors whether they have been invited or not. In effect this means a duty of care towards burglars, would-be burglars, arsonists etc. No harmful booby traps or broken glass on the tops of walls are allowed!

The final lecture which concentrated on what had become a sink estate in Bradford even though it only consisted of some 30 odd flats was turned round and a community spirit re-engendered. It is now regarded as a very desirable place to live.

Overall it was a most interesting if intensive course.
