**Proposed diversion of part of Bridleway No. 6, Ugborough**

Devon County Council is proposing to make a Public Path Order to **divert part of Bridleway No. 6, Ugborough, running through Filham Park near Ivybridge**, as shown on the attached plan.

The effect would be to divert the section of bridleway between points A – C to a line between points A – B – C, around the eastern side of the cricket ground and lake to re-join the existing route south of the lake.

By way of background information, the bridleway was recorded on its current alignment upon the confirmation in 2019 of an evidential Definitive Map Modification Order. The order was made on the basis of long use prior to the construction of the lake and cricket ground. A Diversion Order, made concurrently with the Modification Order, proposed to divert the bridleway along the eastern edge of Filham Park and then around the eastern side of the lake. That Diversion Order has not yet been confirmed, pending accommodation works, and the intention will be to abandon it if this current proposal proceeds.

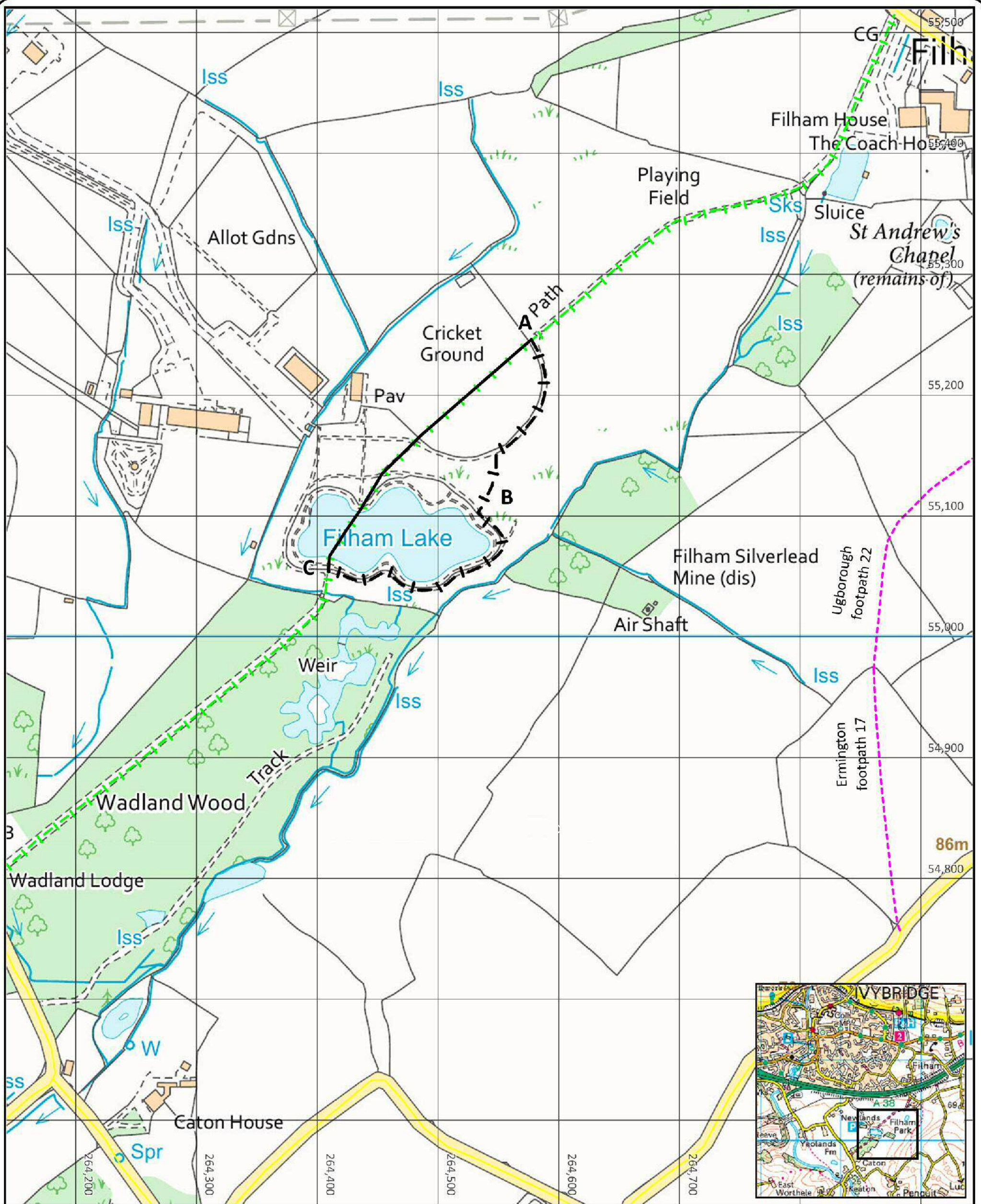
