Filham Park Height Barrier

In June 2021 the Parks and Open Spaces Committee made the following resolution:

PA21/013

It was **RESOLVED** that quotes are sought for a replacement height barrier and the Town Clerk delegated to instruct the work to go ahead as soon as possible. We have been verbally assured by SHDC this can be covered by the S106 funding earmarked for these improvements. It is an essential item so will need to go ahead regardless.

Due to various reasons this work is still to be completed. As it is still unclear when the main track works will be complete and the state of the barrier continues to deteriorate an updated quote has been obtained.

This committee is asked to confirm the previous decision based on the updated quote from the best value supplier obtained last year, now being £2698 + VAT.

It is not clear if this can be funded from the S106 allocation, but is still needed and currently detracts from the entrance at the park, as well as making access difficult and potentially unsafe when the barrier needs opening for servicing vehicles for the grounds maintenance and tenants' service providers.
