CCLA

Attached are two update regarding the Churches, Charities and Local Authorities (CCLA) Local Authorities Property Fund. One from the CCLA themselves and one is a summary prepared by Cllr Dredge from a meeting he attended on 13th April 2021.

We currently have a modest £70,000 invested with CCLA.

Covid Recovery - Retail and Hospitality

The Watermark continues to benefit from grants for Retail, Leisure and Hospitality.
