GRANTS

Each year the Council awards grants to community groups and organisations to support their work in the town for the benefit of residents.

Some are awarded on an application basis, some are awarded on an annual basis, with agreement, based on the ongoing work that the group or organisation are providing in the community.

The following grants are normally awarded on an ongoing basis:

Citizens Advice £1500 – comprising of £1110 cash and £390 towards the room usage at The Watermark

Ring and Ride (IDCTA) £1500

Ivybridge Caring £900

Ivybridge RBL Remembrance Day £700

In addition, this year:

South Hams CVS £2000 – to fund the ongoing health work of the Community Connector in partnership with this Council.

The other grants listed in the budget under 105 Community Grants will be requested when required and the approval sought of this Committee.

It is **recommended** that the specific grants listed are awarded to the relevant bodies and where no report has been received, a request is made for a written report or presentation made to the Town Council during the coming financial year as part of the conditions of the grant award.
