**Councillor Karen Pringle – Ivybridge Town Council.**

Mayor of Ivybridge.

**Councillor Anthony Khong – Ivybridge Town Council.**

Chairman of the Planning & Infrastructure Committee on Ivybridge Town Council.

**Councillor Roger Croad – Devon County Council.**

Devon County Councillor responsible for waste management and advisor on any issues which are undertaken by DCC such as Highways etc. Cllr Croad will also advise the Group on DCC Policies.

**Councillor Mike Saltern – South Hams District Council.**

Advisor on the provision of Housing within the Town and on SHDC Policy issues. Chairman of Governors, Ivybridge Community College.
